About The Masters Of Education Program

The Lake Erie College Masters in Education Program is designed as a rigorous and relevant study of research and contemporary issues impacting teachers in today's schools. Graduate students have the option to complete the requirements in an accelerated track over fifteen months or the more traditional approach of two years.

Requirements For Admission

To be considered for admission, applicants must provide:

- *Evidence of a bachelor's degree with a minimum undergraduate grade point average of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale*
- *A copy of certificate or license issued by the Ohio Department of Education*
- *A completed Graduate application to the Admissions Office with a \$30 non-refundable application fee (the fee is waived if you complete the on-line application)*
- *Official transcripts*
- *Three (3) references, and*
- *Arrange an interview with the Dean of the School of Professional and Innovative Studies*
